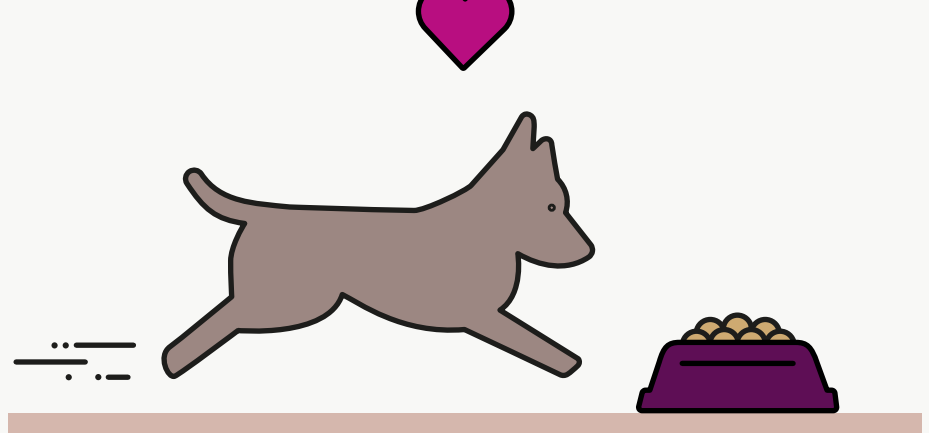
But what are typical cat and dog behaviors around the bowl? Which ones are real signs of food enjoyment? Discover the meaning of cat and dog attitudes during mealtime!



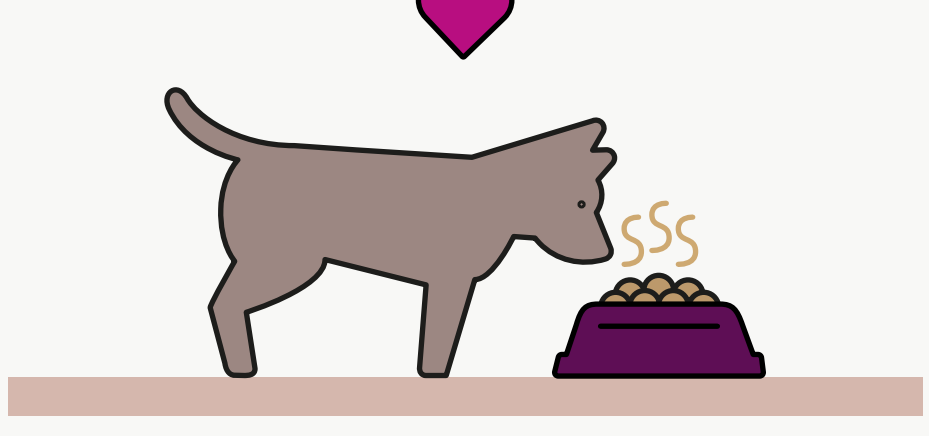
